Course Information

This digital camera class is for novices/beginners who've had their cameras still gift wrapped in the box and have no idea how to use it. They want a better understanding of how to use their cameras while learning the basics of photography. Discussions about photography, lighting, and camera maintenance will take place.

This is not a video class. Do not bring a video camera that takes stills or photos. This is *strictly* a digital camera class. We will not use Photoshop at this point in time. We will learn how to use Windows XP & MS Office 2003 in conjunction with this class.

What to Expect

Weather permitting, we'll take photographs outside. Inside, students will learn how to download their photos to a Folder on their computer or laptop using Windows. You will learn how to create a Folder on the Desktop, a Folder on the fly and how to insert your photos into your e-mails as attachments. Discussions about the internet will take place.

What to Bring

- Camera
 - Owner's manual
 - Transfer cable
 - Tripod, *if you have one*
 - Any size USB to learn how to transfer photos
 - A blank CD/DVD to learn how to burn photos
- Your laptop must have a built in burner for this to work*
